



This map is intended for planning purposes only.

This map depicts the approximate location and extent of areas subject to the SMP. The actual extent of shoreline jurisdiction requires a site-specific evaluation to identify the location of the ordinary high water line and any associated wetlands. The location of the 20 cfs limit is from USGS (1998). Floodplain extent is based on FEMA (1999). Wetland locations are approximate and based on inventoried NWI mapping; additional wetlands may be present that are not shown on the maps and some of the areas shown as wetland may not meet the wetland criteria. This map makes no claim as to whether wetlands are associated with the shoreline or not.
